What is your commitment as an advisor?

You will meet virtually with CWC PCN representatives and other community members every three months for two years. The meetings will be held on weekday evenings and last up to 90 minutes. In the meetings, you will be asked to listen to presentations and provide feedback regarding a range of programs and services.
